## CHILD ADVANCEMENT PROJECT (CAP)

CAP matches students in grades K-12 with an adult volunteer mentor from our community. Supervised by Thrive Liaisons, matches meet one-on-one, for one hour per week during school.

- Mentors are screened, trained, and supervised by a Thrive Liaison
- Matches study, play games, create projects, and build a friendship
- CAP is a nationally-recognized, evidence-based program that has positively impacted students for over 30 years. Some CAP matches have been together for over a decade.

**Could my child benefit from CAP?** Kids are nominated for a number of reasons. From being new to town, going through family changes, or needing to be challenged more at school, give your Thrive Liaison a call to chat about whether this program would be a good fit for your child.



## THRIVE LIAISON PROGRAM
