Long Beach has been recognized as the most ethnically and culturally diverse municipality among the nation's 100 largest cities. Opened in 1895, and located in the inner city, the school enrolls 4,080 students in grades 9-12. Long Beach Poly is accredited by the Western Association Schools and Colleges. According to the California Department of Education 57% of our students are considered socioeconomically disadvantaged. 13% are English Language Learners, 1.28% are foster youth, and 9% of our students have identified disabilities.

Since 2002, the Long Beach Unified School District does not rank students.


GPA CALCULATION
