### COMMUNITY

Bowling Green, Ohio is a college community of nearly 32,000 located 20 miles south of Toledo in a rich agricultural area. Bowling Green State University (approximately 19,700 students) enhances the intellectual, cultural and recreational opportunities of the community.

### SCHOOL/FACULTY

Bowling Green High School is a public, 4-year comprehensive high school accredited by the Ohio Department of Education. The 2024-2025 enrollment is 918 including 159 Bowling Green students enrolled in vocational programs coordinated by Penta Career Center. The graduating class of 2024 totaled 204 students. The school is staffed with 57 teachers, 3 school counselors, 3 administrators, and 21 support personnel including 2 EdD conferees, 45 educators with master's degrees and 16 with bachelor's degrees. The Library Media Center houses nearly 16,000 volumes as well as access to the Internet, computerized magazine and newspaper databases, and other electronic resources.

### ATHLETICS

Bowling Green High School offers 13 boys and 13 girls interscholastic varsity sports as a member of the Northern Lakes League and the Ohio High School Athletic Association.

### HIGH SCHOOL VISITATIONS/COLLEGE FAIR

College admission representatives may schedule a high school visit by calling or writing to the Counseling Office. Bowling Green High School participates in the Northern Wood County College Fair each fall and College Preview Night at Owens Community College each spring.

### CURRICULUM

Bowling Green High School offers honors, accelerated, advanced placement, college preparatory, and pre-vocational courses. AP examinations are available in all core academic areas. Penta Career Center offers 30 vocational programs for Juniors/Seniors and hosts a Sophomore Exploratory program.

### COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS (CCP)

Bowling Green High School participates in Ohio's College Credit Plus dual enrollment program. Eligible students may enroll in college courses for high school and/or college credit. In Fall 2024, 170+ BGHS students were enrolled in dual enrollment courses at BGSU and Owens.

### WORLD LANGUAGE COURSES

French and Spanish Level I, II, III, and IV are offered for high school credit beginning in 7<sup>th</sup> grade. Level V Spanish and BGSU dual credit Intermediate Spanish I and II are offered upon sufficient demand.

### HONORS/ACCELERATED COURSES ON WEIGHTED 4.0 SCALE

There are 20 Honors and Accelerated courses which are assigned quality points based on the above grading scales. GPA is computed by dividing quality points by credits attempted in all courses except for courses taken on a P/F basis.

**English (5):** Honors English 9, Honors World Culture Studies, Honors English 10, AP English Language and Composition, AP English Literature and Composition.

**Social Studies (6):** Honors World History, Honors World Culture Studies, Honors American History, AP United States History, AP United States Government & Politics, and AP World History: Modern.

**Science (3):** Honors Biology, AP Biology, and AP Chemistry.

**Mathematics (5):** Honors Geometry, Honors Algebra II/Trigonometry, Honors Pre-Calculus, AP Calculus AB, and AP Statistics. Algebra I is considered accelerated and is weighted if taken in 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> grade.
