Junior and senior students at the high school are eligible to select classes at Eastern Center for Arts and Technology (EASTERN). This partnership allows our students to take advantage of the current technologies in career fields at EASTERN and includes the opportunity to continue their education in college. At EASTERN, academics are blended with applied learning just as a lab course in college provides students with a hands-on interactive supplement to theory courses. EASTERN provides the technical experience that will give your child a competitive edge in the workplace or college. They also offer articulation college credit agreements with a growing number of colleges and universities and dual enrollment through Montgomery County Community College.
