



After 3 Club Program Information

After 3 Club is NPS's aftercare program available to all students. It operates daily when school is in session, except on days when school closes at noon.

Active/Outdoor Play: Due to playground construction, active play will take place in the NPS sports field and Jones Hall (gym). From September 5 to October 29, outdoor time is limited on Mondays and Tuesdays due to NPS Team Soccer practices.

Registration is through the [CampBrain](#) website. Students can be registered for the full year or specific seasons (Fall, Winter, Spring). Single-season registrations require re-registration each season. If After 3 Club was included in your tuition, no further registration is needed. Financial assistance applies to families receiving Financial Aid.

Drop-In Options:

- **Weekly Drop-In:** Sign up by 6 pm the Friday before the desired day via the [Weekly Drop-In Reservation form](#). Cost: \$32/day.
- **Last-Minute Drop-In:** Notify the school by 2 pm the day of via email to frontdesk@nps-dc.org. Cost: \$45/day. Late pickups after 3:30 pm automatically incur the last-minute fee.

Dismissal Changes: Notify the Front Desk by 2 pm (11 am on Noon Dismissal days) if you wish to pick up your child from carpool instead of After 3 Club. Without notification, please park and walk to the main entrance for pick-up.

Pick Up: Students can be picked up anytime between 3:15 and 6 pm. Caregivers must park, sign out at the Front Desk, and wait while staff bring the student. Late pickups after 6 pm incur a \$2/minute fee.

Groupings & Activities: Students are grouped by grade or small grade bands. The program includes a snack, indoor/outdoor play, and a structured activity. Students in Grades 2-6 also have a supervised study hall. Electronics are not allowed.

Noon Dismissal Days: On Noon Dismissal days, After 3 Club runs from 12 to 6 pm, with slight schedule adjustments. Pre-K 3 – Pre-K 4 students have a rest period, while Kindergarten-6th Grade students watch a movie or participate in special activities. When the school closes at noon for holidays or before breaks, After 3 Club is not offered. Please see the school calendar for these dates.

Staff & Training: After 3 Club is managed by experienced staff who undergo comprehensive background checks and receive training in health and safety, classroom management, and NPS policies.

Conduct & Behavior: After 3 Club follows the same conduct policies as the school day. Repeatedly disruptive or unsafe behavior may result in dismissal or suspension from the program without a refund.
