WHAT WE DO

The Arc's Family Support Services (FSS) program provides free one-on-one guidance, helping care providers develop and implement plans that address the immediate and long-term needs of their family members with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD). Our team is available to help with:

- Connecting families to community resources like funding programs, medical providers, respite care, support groups, case management services and advocacy.
- Planning for post-graduation supports such as day programs, vocational training, guardianship and alternatives, special needs trusts, and residential opportunities.

Working closely with school districts and specializing in transition services, the staff help families in Bexar and surrounding counties access community-based services throughout all stages of life. There are no income or age restrictions to meet with an FSS Coordinator.
