## Instructions for Personal Graduation Plan Checklist

### Coursework

House Bill 5 (HB 5), passed by the 83rd Texas Legislature and signed by the governor, provides for a new set of graduation plans for Texas students. These graduation plans consist of a foundation plan for every Texas student and five endorsements from which students may choose, depending on their interests. When selected, students will complete each of these endorsements with four Mathematics, four Science, four English Language Arts, and three Social Studies credits. Students are also required to complete two foreign language credits.

Students entering 9<sup>th</sup> Grade must choose from one of the following endorsements:

- STEM
- Business and Industry
- Arts and Humanities
- Public Services
- Multidisciplinary Studies

Students may change their endorsement at any time prior to graduation.

To qualify as part of the top ten percent of their graduating class, students must successfully complete Algebra II.

### Testing

Students are required to pass five State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR<sup>®</sup>) end-of-course exams to meet the new graduation requirements:

- Algebra I
- English I (Reading/Writing)
- English II (Reading/Writing)
- Biology
- US History
