  - a. Mrs. Allen stressed the need for regular attendance over the course of this 3.5-year commitment. In the future, meetings will be conducted at the schools.

  - a. BMS North OCO/Pfluger: Mark Oppelt provided detail on the phases of the project. In response to a question, Mr. Oppelt gave detail on student safety during construction, including a note that much of the work will take place during the summers. A process for selecting energy management systems (across the district) will be incorporated.
  - b. BMS South OCO/Pfluger: Mr. Oppelt provided detail on the different phases of the project. Adding nine new classrooms and nine science classroom/labs. As many oak trees as possible being preserved on the site. Adding cafeteria capacity, including outdoor dining courtyard.

- c. Curington ES SHW: Mr. Perez provided detail on the project. The new, larger capacity front drop-off loop was described (40-car capacity). Kitchen and cafeteria being expanded. Anticipated completion date: August 2015.
- d. Transportation OCO/Pfluger: Mr. Oppelt provided detail on this project, which is anticipated to be under construction by the first quarter of 2014; complete by summer 2014. Sixteen additional bus spaces will be provided. Additional warehouse space will be gained.
- e. Champion HS Parking, sidewalk & track surfacing MTR: Mr. Martin provided detail of this project. Will get started on these projects by last quarter 2013, first quarter 2014, pending approvals. Mr. Martin also provided an update on the CHS welding shop upgrades; operational by week of 9/16/13.
