Connection to Resources, Support and Guidance

If necessary, you'll be connected to emergency services.

Your program includes up to three counseling sessions per issue. Sessions can be done in person. on the phone, by video or text.

Addictions such as alcohol and drug abuse Stress or anxiety with work




