Congratulations to our Food Service Managers for earning SERV Safe Certified Managers. SERV Safe is a nationally accredited certification program on food safety designed by the National Restaurant Association. It has become the leading food safety certification in the US. It is a coveted credential in the food service industry. SERV Safe certification programs are based on guidelines and requirements found in the US Food Code.

The SERV safe Manager certification is the highest certification awarded by SERV safe. The certification verifies that a manager or person in charge has sufficient food safety knowledge to protect the public from foodborne illnesses. Individuals that successfully pass the 90-question exam are awarded the Manager certification.




