APPLYING FOR A JUNIOR SCHOOL PLACE

Although we have only just returned it is now time for Year 2 parents to apply for a junior school place for their child. Please visit the ESCC website and click on Apply for a school place. This will take you through to start the process for applying. All applications must be made by 15th January 2025.

MEDICAL TRACKER

As most parents are aware, we use Medical Tracker for the reporting of all first aid incidents that occur at Dudley. This system allows us to monitor particular areas where incidents are occurring and times of the day. This in turn supports us with our Health and Safety processes, as we can then put strategies in place to help avoid any potential accidents. If your child has a first aid incident at school, Medical Tracker allows us to notify you immediately of this by email. We will, of course, ring you if we feel that the incident is of a concern.

NSPCC RESOURCES & SUPPORT

This year, we will continue to participate in the NSPCC's *Speak out. Stay safe.* programme. This consists of an online assembly and supporting classroom based activities. *Speak out. Stay safe.* is an important safeguarding programme available to all primary schools in the UK and aims to help children understand abuse in all its forms and to recognise the signs of abuse in a child friendly way. Children are taught to speak out if

they are worried, either to a trusted adult or Childline. As part of our PSHE and RHE curriculum, we will also spend time in class and in assembly, teaching 'The Underwear Rule', via the online video, 'Pantosaurus', raising awareness of the importance of talking to children about keeping safe.
