

Walled Lake Schools is asking the community to replace the current operating millage with an 18 mill non-homestead millage that represents roughly \$31 million and a 3.6297 mill hold harmless millage that represents approximately \$2 million of the District's budget.

> VOTE ON OR BEFORE NOV 5

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property in the Walled Lake Consolidated school District, County of Oakland, Michigan, be increased in the amount of 21 mills, with 18 mills being the maximum allowable levy (\$18.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value), to the extent such property is not statutorily exempt, and of which not more than 3.6297 mills may be imposed on principal residences, for fourteen (14) years, the years 2024 to 2037, inclusive? This operating millage, if approved and levied, would provide estimated revenues to the School District of \$3,232,239 during the 2024 calendar year, to be used for deneral operating purposes.
