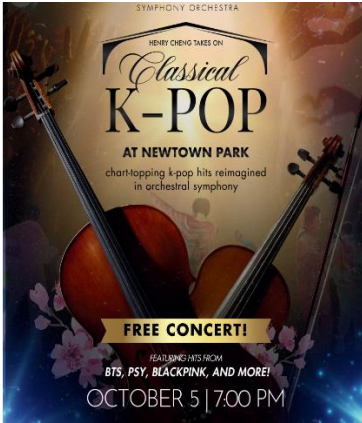


2024 PRESIDENTIAL GENERAL ELECTION
