MORE IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Medication at School

<u>lf your child needs to take medication</u> <u>during the school day:</u>

- A medication Authorization Form must be completed and turned into the school office for ALL medications (including over the counter items like cough drops, ointments & pain medications)
- Prescription medications require a Medication Authorization Form that is signed by the parent AND a physician. Prescription meds cannot be given at school without a completed med form.
- ALL medications must be in the original container/packaging. Prescription meds must be in the pharmacy labeled container.
- Students should not bring meds to school. An adult must deliver the medication directly to the office.

*Per District policy, **ALL** absences exceeding 10 days will be marked unexcused unless a medical excuse is provided.*

Breakfast & Lunch

JACKSON IS A CEP SCHOOL

Jackson is part of the Community Eligibility Provision or CEP. CEP is a non-pricing meal option for schools and school districts in low income areas. CEP allows us to serve **breakfast and lunch at**

no cost to ALL enrolled students. That said, we still encourage families to complete a food service application to see if you qualify for additional waived fees.

Students are encouraged to arrive to school in time for breakfast (7:45 AM) whether they eat at school or home. Students may bring their own cold lunch to school if they wish. Cold lunch students have the option to purchase a carton of milk for \$.50.

Tardy Students

We understand that unforeseen circumstances can occur, however we ask that you do your best to be on time for drop off and pick up of your students. Tardy students disrupt the general routine of the entire classroom.

Students who are late to school or picked up early must be signed in/out by an adult in the office.

ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

Traffic & Parking Guidelines

The safety of our students is of utmost importance! Please adhere to the guidelines below when dropping off and picking up your children:

- 1. Use the North side of Langlade Ave. (school side of the road) to drop off. This is intended to be a DROP ZONE ONLY. Traffic MUST keep moving. Vehicles should NOT be left unattended.
- 2. Parents who would like to walk their children to the blacktop should park on Briquelet St., the South side of Langlade Ave. OR the Calvary Lutheran Church parking lot. Students MUST cross the street at a crosswalk with an adult.
- 3. PLEASE do NOT pick up or drop off on Ridge Rd. This space is for buses & daycare vehicles ONLY.
- 4. The parking lot behind the school is for Jackson Staff members ONLY. Please refrain from picking up and dropping off in the cul de sac on Russell Street. In the past this area has become too congested and is not safe for our walking students.

Arrival & Dismissal

4K STUDENTS

Drop off & pick up for 4K students is Door #11 on Ninth Street.

4K AM: 7:40 AM - 10:45 AM **4K PM**: 11:30 AM - 2:35 PM

K-5TH GRADERS

Drop off & pick up for K - 5th grade students is on the blacktop between the school & playground.

7:35 AM: Drop off begins. Students should not be dropped off any earlier. Supervision begins at 7:35 AM!

7:45 AM: Breakfast bell - students will enter the building through their designated doors **7:57 AM**: Late bell - students arriving after this time should enter through the main office. A parent/guardian must come in to sign the student in.

2:35 PM: Dismissal - students will exit through their designated doors onto the blacktop.
