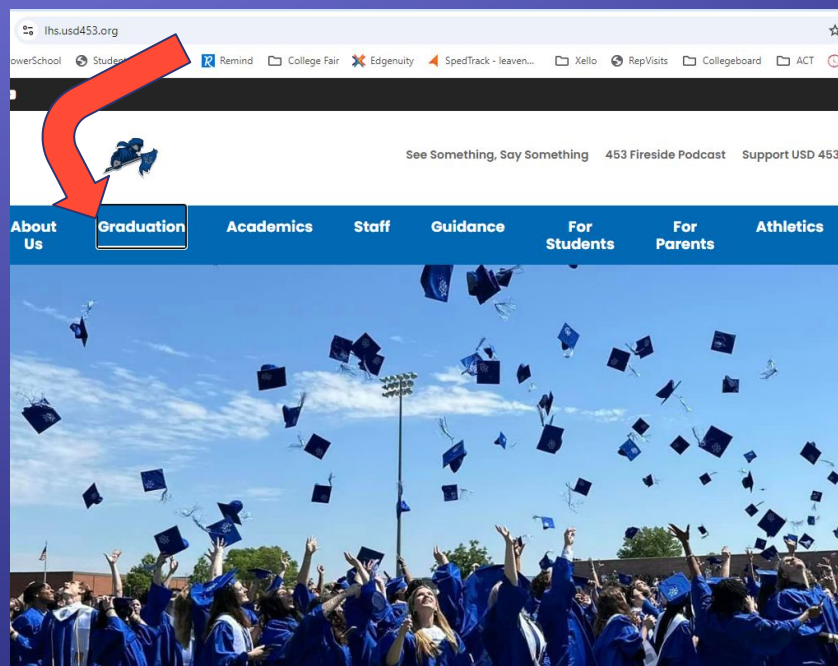

BOOKKEEPING INFORMATION FOR GRADUATING SENIORS

(Page 5)

- **ALL DEBTS MUST BE SATISFIED PRIOR TO PARTICIPATING IN GRADUATION EXERCISES.** Seniors will not receive their cap and gown until all textbooks/materials, uniforms, equipment, library books/fines, etc. are turned in or paid for.
- **NO CHECKS**, only cash, money order, credit or debit card, will be accepted for payment after MAY 1.
- Outstanding account invoices are mailed to parents monthly. Student accounts with outstanding balances as of MARCH 1 will be sent to a collection agency.
- Students must turn in items to the appropriate teacher, coach, or to the Bookkeeping office. For every textbook returned the student should receive the blue book receipt they signed when they were issued the book and it should be signed and dated as returned by the teacher or bookkeeper. Students need to keep these book receipts as proof that the books were returned.
- If you have been charged for an item and feel the charge is in error, then it is the student's responsibility to discuss this with the teacher, coach, librarian, etc. as soon as possible. The teacher, coach, librarian, etc. will then email the bookkeeping office if the charge is to be removed.



The FAFSA form will be unavailable due to scheduled maintenance every Sunday from 3–11 a.m. Eastern time.

FAFSA® Deadlines

Many states and colleges set priority deadlines by which you must submit the FAFSA form to be considered for the aid programs they administer.

There is also a federal deadline each academic year.



Make Sure You...

- ❑ Students and contributors must electronically sign the FAFSA through their own account at the end of the application.
- ❑ Parents are contributors and must provide their data if you do not meet federal criteria of an independent student.
- ❑ You may need to be admitted to the school before they can retrieve your FAFSA. KCKCC School Code: 001925
- ❑ Estimated release date is December 1, but you must also comply with your school priority deadline. Apply as early as possible!
- ❑ KCKCC Priority Deadline is April 1, 2025.



Final Steps and Tips

- ❑ Final high school transcripts should be submitted to each college/university that you are submitting the FAFSA to. You can list up to 20 schools.
- ❑ FSA ID information must match exactly in all areas, including FSA ID, Tax information, Social Security Administration, and your FAFSA.
- ❑ Additional scholarship resources are available on institutional websites but will have specific deadlines. KCKCC offers new scholarships each semester.
- ❑ High school counseling staff are a great resource for community scholarships.
- ❑ Kansas Apply Free Days October 7-9, 2024 (kansasregents.org)
- ❑ Apply early and use your resources
