Congratulations, your cumulative grade point average qualifies you for consideration for membership in the Radnor High School Chapter of *National Honor Society* which strives to bring the achievements of outstanding high school students to the attention of their classmates, parents, communities, and the colleges they plan to attend. You are to be commended for attaining an excellent academic record; however, please understand that membership is not guaranteed and selection into the Radnor Chapter of NHS is a privilege, not a right. Membership is not automatically conveyed simply because a student has achieved a specified level of academic performance. NHS is more than just honor roll.

Selection Process

To be considered for membership in the *National Honor Society*, please complete the Membership Packet found in here or on the RHS National Honor Society webpage (located on the Radnor High School website, under the Activities Tab). Candidates must submit a completed membership packet providing evidence of service, character, and leadership in the form of recommendations, a well-thought personal statement, and completed information sheet that will be used by our local selection committee to support their candidacy for membership. By completing this Membership Packet, Candidates acknowledge that they accept the process of selection by the faculty council and understand that selection is final. Membership is granted only to those students selected by the Faculty Council in each school. Again, *the detailed, step-by-step process for submitting a Candidate Packet can be found in this packet or on Radnor High School's website under the Activities Tab, National Honor Society.*

It is the candidate's responsibility for obtaining two service recommendations, two character recommendations, and one leadership recommendation showcasing three pillars of NHS – service, character, and leadership. Candidates must use the forms provided in this document and may not use their own forms. Recommenders can be in or out of school and may be teachers, coaches, church members, social group coordinators, employers, etc.; however, *they may not be current students or immediate family members.* Candidates are responsible for letting the recommenders know that the documents are *TIME SENSITIVE* and will not be accepted late. Directions for submitting recommendations are at the top of each form.

Membership Information Packet Deadline:

The contents of this Membership Information Packet are *TIME SENSITIVE* and must be completed and **submitted to Mr. Kim in Room 125 no later than 8:30am Monday, October 14th, 2024.** Any Candidate Documents not received, or Candidate Packets not fully completed by this date will not be considered. ***Be sure to read all the documents carefully.**

Finally, Candidates who are accepted into the Radnor Chapter of National Honor Society must participate in our mandatory **Induction Ceremony on November 11, 2024, at 7:30 pm in the RHS Auditorium.**
