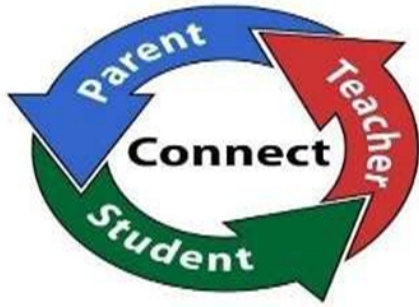


District Goals

Northwest Early College High School Goals for Student Achievement

- Students earn their associate degree and high school diploma simultaneously.
- For the school year 2024-2025, all students will pass the EOC exams on the first attempt. The number of students earning a Master's level will increase by at least 5%.
- NWECHS will retain 95% of our incoming freshman class. (from freshmen to sophomore year) as indicated through the enrollment data of the last day of school in May 2025.
- By May 2025, all students in the class of 2028 will have passed the ELA TSI 2.0. All students enrolled in Algebra II will have passed the math TSI.
- For the 2024-2025 school year, NWECHS will reach the goal of 98.0% attendance in all grade levels through increased focus on accurate attendance record keeping, use of positive attendance incentives, PBIS strategies, parent meetings, and parent/student attendance plan needed.
