

TRANSPORTATION VEHICLE PARKING – HIGH SCHOOL

Learners are allowed to drive their standard motor vehicle to school provided they have a valid driver's license. School officials will designate areas for learner parking on the campus. Learners must purchase a parking permit to park in the parking lot. Learners are to park in the learner parking area of the school parking lot. Parking permits are only valid for the school year they are purchased, a new parking permit is required each school year. Parking permits do not guarantee parking spots to be available in the school lot. A learner may purchase a permit in the office for \$15.00. If a learner loses their permit, they may purchase a replacement in the school office. Parking permits must be hung on rear view mirror of vehicle when parked in the parking lot.

All types of off-road motorized vehicles, including but not limited to ATVs, UTVs, and snowmobiles are prohibited on school property. All motorcycles must be parked in the designated parking area in the learner parking lot. Bicycles must be parked in bicycle racks and locked. Learners cannot park in any visitor, faculty, arena, or fire lane parking areas. All parking signs must be obeyed. Parking tickets will be issued and a fine of \$15.00 per ticket must be paid to the main office. If a learner accumulates 3 tickets during a school year, they will not be allowed to park on campus. After 3 tickets have been issued, parents/guardians will be notified that the school reserves the right to have the learners' vehicle towed at the owner's expense if the learner receives another parking ticket in the current school year.
