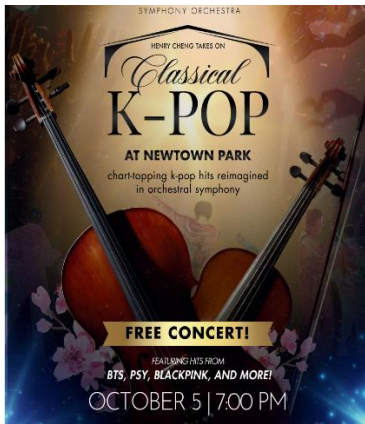


### 2024 PRESIDENTIAL GENERAL ELECTION
