New Financial Aid Dates Announced!

Financial Aid applications for the 2025/2026 school year opened today, Sept. 15, 2024. The new application deadline is Dec. 15, 2024.

FAQ

Why have you changed the Financial Aid Application deadline? We understand that independent school tuition is a serious commitment that requires financial planning. Moving up the application date will allow us to offer financial aid awards in January during re-enrollment.

What information do I need to provide? You will need to upload your 2023 Federal Tax Returns, supporting schedules and forms, and W-2s or 1099s. If you applied for financial aid for the 2024/2025 school year you have likely already uploaded these documents!

Last year I uploaded my 2023 Federal Tax Returns, supporting schedules and forms, and W-2s or 1099s. Do I need to upload them again? No, this information will carry over to the 2025/2026 Financial Aid Application.

What other steps must I complete to apply for 2025/2026 Financial Aid? Both new and returning financial aid applicants must complete the 2025/2026 Financial Aid Request Form AND the FACTS Grant and Aid Application.
