Principal Report

- Birthday Lunch- Mr. Lichey went around with a birthday cart to give cookies and a small squishy toy. Happens once a month. Summer birthdays will be celebrated.
- Celebrate Wyandot report card score- (number represents how many students went from off track to on track.) We went from 3 stars to 4 stars overall. Early Literacy went from 1 to 3 stars. District Wide we scored 4.5 stars. All numbers are out of 5.
- Student attendance is being looked at more closely. A letter goes home if a student misses more than 35 hours a month.
- There are three new curriculums this year at Wyandot. Everyone in the district has been trained on the science of reading and Dyslexia. ELA Program is a knowledge building curriculum to help them grow in comprehension. Also working on the foundational piece to help build strong readers. New Math Program and Foundations Program called Hegerty.
