The application deadline is January 10, 2025. The completed application checklist deadline is February 1, 2025.

- Parent and Student Meeting (*in-person only*)** – Parent(s) and student meet with a member from the admissions team on campus. This 20-minute visit is a time for us to learn more about your child and family, provide program details, answer questions, and get to know your family.

- Developmental Questionnaire** – Parents complete this questionnaire from the checklist and must be completed prior to the parent interview.
- Play Group on Campus (*in-person only*)** – Parent brings student to campus for a 45-minute classroom experience to assess school readiness, age-appropriate milestones, and social emotional skills. Parent will schedule this through the application checklist.
- Parent Interview (*virtual*)** – Parent(s) will have the opportunity to connect with a member of the admissions team via Teams. This is an opportunity for applicant families to share more about their child and family, become familiar with the school, and discuss any specific program information or questions they may have.
