Ansonia High School (AHS) will introduce the interactive online platform Pathful to teachers and students this Fall. The Pathful platform is a K-16 workforce readiness system that integrates college and career readiness, work-based learning, and employability skills. Students will use the platform to build awareness of career options with career profiles, learn about education and skills requirements for a variety of careers, and be introduced to earning and salary potential. Additionally, teachers and students can hear from virtual guest speakers, participate in virtual industry-led projects, and view on-demand virtual job shadowing videos. Pathful will help ensure AHS students are prepared to be competitive and adaptable in the ever-evolving workplace.

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
