Classroom Guidance

The counselor will conduct classroom guidance activities throughout the school year. The goal will be to develop an awareness of self, others, and the world around them using Character Education.

Small Group Counseling

Activities are designed to help students experience self-confidence, friendship, decision making, attitude and behavior changes. Some groups are formed by grade level, and some are formed with students sharing a common concern.

Individual Counseling
