## Board Meeting Action Items

The Board approved the Consent

#### APPROVE PROPOSED FINDINGS OF CM/GC FOR ROSEBURG HIGH SCHOOL VO-TECH EAST BUILDING SEISMIC RENOVATION

The Board unanimously approved the proposed findings and use of the Construction Manager / General Contractor (CM/GC) method of procurement for the RHS Vo-Tech East Building Seismic Rehabilitation grant project described during tonight's Public The \$2,499,420 Hearing. grant will seismically strengthen the RHS Vo-Tech East Building to both life safety and immediate occupancy standards.

#### Adoption of Upcoming School Year Calendar

Asst. Superintendent Michelle Knee shared that the Calendar Committee met to review options for the 2025-26 school year calendar, with potential start dates both before and after the Labor Day holiday. The School Board unanimously adopted the 2025-2026 school year calendar with a start date after Labor Day, accepting the recommendation of both the district Calendar Committee and Board A & P Committee.
