### Graduation/Transfer-Out Rate

The undergraduate graduation/transfer-out rate represents the percentage of students who successfully complete their educational goals and do so in an expected timeframe, or who transfer to programs at other institutions of higher education. Saint Constantine College recognizes that a year or two of Great Texts general education is the goal of some students who may otherwise attend an institution of higher education that offers upper-division professional/vocational degree programs. As such, students who transfer to programs at other institutions of higher education, rather than complete an entire degree at Saint Constantine College, are included as “transfer-out” students.

This rate is reported as both a four-year graduation/transfer-out rate and a six-year graduation/transfer-out rate. Saint Constantine College aims to have a higher-than-average graduation rate due to our commitment to excellence in education.

The College tracks graduation/transfer-out rates by various subgroups. In each category below, the goal will be given by subgroup.

Saint Constantine College was recognized in August 2021 by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board as an institution with the authority to grant degrees. The first cohort of students who transferred into our BA program in Fall 2021 as sophomores (cohort of 2020) is expected to graduate in Spring 2024. The four-year undergraduate graduation rate for that cohort will be available in June 2024.
