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Academic Information

GRADES AND CREDITS

Each school year is divided into two semesters. Progress Reports are issued midway through each semester and serve as a warning to students who have a grade below C minus. Semester grades appear on permanent records.

For each class passed, students earn either 2.5 or 5 five credits per semester depending on student attendance. In order to graduate in four years, students should earn 60 credits per year and at least 230 by graduation time. Refer to the table on page 5 for specific graduation requirements.

CREDIT RECOVERY AND ADVANCEMENT

*Oakdale Charter is not a Credit Remediation school, meaning we have limited options to make up missing Graduation Requirements

SUMMER SCHOOL

Students who fail a required class or fall behind in the number of credits needed for graduation should make up these deficiencies in summer school, if it is offered. Students may also use the 7-period schedule option to make up two semesters of a required class. Classes are filled in the order applications are received.

EDGENUITY

Students who are at least 16 years of age have access to Edgenuity. Seats are filled on a first come, first serve basis with Seniors and Juniors having priority. Edgenuity is an online high school course program for students who are credit deficient, have impacted schedules, or seeking grade improvement. Students can take one course, per semester. Students are required to attend courses on-site one day a week for 3 hours. The rest of the course is expected to be completed by the students on their own time. Please see your teacher for an application that includes objectives, computer access expectations and student responsibility.

COMMUNITY COLLEGE COURSES

Oakdale Charter School students can enroll in courses offered through Columbia College, Modesto Junior College, Merced College, and Delta College. Students should make an appointment with their teacher for more information on course offerings and the application process. Oakdale Charter students who pass college courses can earn elective credit towards their high school diploma.

AP Classes/Credit

Advanced Placement classes are not offered. However, any student wishing to take an AP Exam may do so. Please speak to your teacher or the Teacher-in-Charge for more information.
