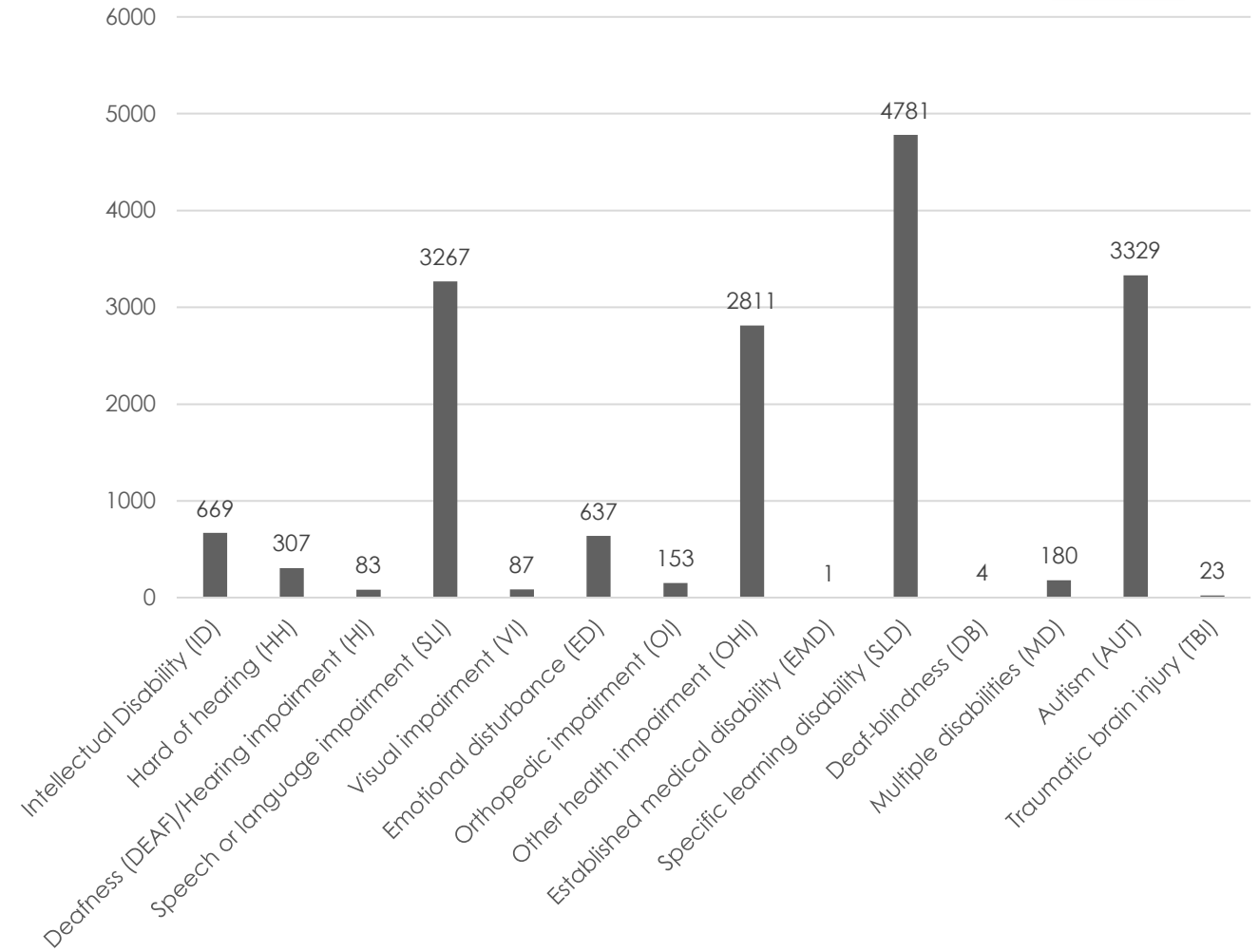

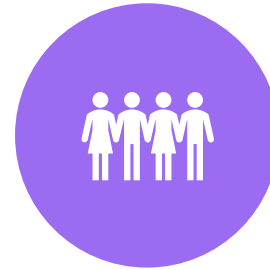

Services include telephone intermediary, case management, IEP facilitation, and mediation.
