Discussion Item

- Palmetto Elementary Strategic Plan
 - GMAS ELA/Math Students scoring proficient or distinguished on ELA and Math GMAS will increase by 3%.
 - Decrease total day of Out of School Suspension (OSS) from 35 to 30. We are looking at doing something in-house to reduce OSS. We need someone to facilitate the daily management of the in-house resource. Bus behavior is also a concern.
 - o Ensure Impactful Programming Increase the number of students in ADV/ACC in grades 3-5 from 15 students to 21 students.
 - o Strengthen Employee Engagement Acknowledge employee attendance
 - o Student Attendance Decrease percent of students absent 10% or more.
- Charter Dollars
 - The amount increased from \$44,000 to \$46,000.
 - Funds will be used for school beautification, printers, ink, a banner, materials and supplies, t-shirts for students, a camera to take pictures of those who receive Student of the Month.
 - Rugs for 3rd grade and PreK
 - K-2 and 3-5 Graham Fletcher kit

School Updates

- We have earned a kindergarten class; waiting for the district to complete the surplus process.
- We will gain a paraprofessional through the surplus process.
- Ms. Lorick is expected to fill the vacancy of the added kindergarten class.
- There are currently no students for the ½ day SNPreK class.
- Ms. Bishop was promoted to a position at Banneker High School. Ms. Traille is serving as the long-term substitute for the $1^{st}/2^{nd}$ SEC class.
- Dr. White acknowledged Ms. Truitt for implementing worksheet free engaging lessons/tasks and fostering student collaboration during instruction.
