- Concerns from Parents about Safety/Bullying
 - Students are being injured and bullied at school and want to know what is being done
 - There are repeat issues with the same students, but nothing seems to be changing
 - What are the processes in place to address safety and bullying issues?
 - School crisis team
 - Are they trained?
 - No, training is out of date
 - What are they allowed to do when trained?
 - “Safe restraints”
 - Staff are not really supposed to touch children though
 - Increased supervision
 - One-on-one supervision for the child(ren)
 - Behavior support plan
 - Behavior supports
 - Therapists
 - Mr. Littlehale is currently staffing the main office and is having difficulty addressing issues as the principal in a timely fashion
 - How are the rest of the students still learning?
 - “The rest of the students are in another room”
 - What can we do to ensure that Fulton is staff enough to provide supports for safety and learning
 - What supports are OTHER students who are witnessing these safety and bullying issues receiving?
 - Student assistant program
 - Licensed therapist
 - Behavior/safety plans for victims
