Student Cell Phone Use

This year, the School Board will engage the school district community to help inform the creation of a student cell phone use policy.

Cell phone advisory group

A cell phone advisory group of students, parents and teachers will work collaboratively with administration to develop recommendations for cell phone use by educational level (elementary school, middle school, high school). These recommendations will be provided to the School Board so they can use them as they develop a cell phone policy in compliance with new legislation.



Legislation passed during the 2024 Minnesota State Legislative session A school district or charter school must adopt a policy on students' possession and use of cell phones in school by March 15, 2025. – Minn. Stat. § 121A.73

Note: In general, all guidelines related to cell phones also apply to the use of smartwatches, AirPods, earbuds and headphones unless directly related to learning or instruction.


