There are several learning options available for freshmen or upper classmen seeking credit recovery. Students can also earn dual credit in the summer program through St Louis Community College.

The Exponential Growth model included in the Literacy Plan allows for students to accelerate their learning as a result of simultaneous reading and writing across the disciplines.

Data teams will engage once a month on Data Team Monday. The Team will examine academic and social-emotional data. The purpose of the team:  
-Collect and review grade level academic and behavioral data with the grade-level or content area team  
-Engage in problem solving when grade level or content areas concerns arise that inhibit student outcomes  
-Provide ongoing support through the creation of interventions  
Data: Grades, screener data, progress monitoring data, panorama, etc.

Quarterly walkthroughs using the Universals Checklist, by C & I, Principals, and Teacher Instructional Leaders, will ensure universal curriculum and instructional practices are being implemented accordingly. Feedback will be used to assist teachers in improving their practices around the universal curriculum.

Principals and Teacher Instructional Leaders will engage in the Transformational Leadership Institute where they receive professional development to improve their leadership around instruction and SEL.
