



## School-Family Compact New Digital Signature Process

- All students above 10 years of age should sign digitally.
- All parents/guardians are asked to digitally sign the School-Family Compact regardless of their child's age.
- Your digital signature acknowledges you have read, received, and agree to the School-Family Compact.
- Parents and students can digitally sign by using the online portal or the app on their smartphone/device.

### What Is a School-Family Compact?

A School-Family Compact for Achievement is an agreement that families, students, and teachers develop together. It explains how families and teachers will work together to make sure all students get the individual support they need to reach and exceed grade-level standards.
