School Fees

Picture Retake Day

Picture Retake Day will be **Tuesday October 1 from 7:30 am - 9:00 am**. This is for the students that would like to retake pictures and any student or staff that missed or still needs to get their picture taken.

Homecoming Guests

If you plan to bring a **non-DePere High School student** to the Homecoming Dance on Saturday, October 12th, <u>you must pick up and complete a Guest Pass Application</u> which can be found in the main office. This application will need signatures from parent/guardian and the guest's administrator. **It is due back by Friday, October 4th.**

PSAT/NMSQT Test

The PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) will be administered at DPHS on **Wednesday**, **October 23**, **2024**. This standardized test is <u>optional</u> for any junior and <u>the cost is \$19.00</u>. This is a digital test that the student will take on their school issued Chrome book. The test is approximately three hours in length.

There are two main reasons to take this test:

1. If you are a student who typically tests in the 95-99th percentile on standardized tests. Most students who qualify for the National Merit Scholarship program are in the top 5-10% of their class and typically test in the 95-99th percentile on standardized tests.

2. If your parent(s) works for a corporation that provides scholarship opportunities based on a PSAT score.

Due to the fact that colleges continue to use a test optional approach for college admission and that all colleges accept either ACT or SAT scores, the PSAT may not be a test that makes sense to take.

If you decide to take this test, you must email DPHS counselor Marcy Becker (<u>mbecker@depere.k12.wi.us</u>) no later than **Monday, September 30, 2024 at 3:04pm.** Once the student's name has been added to the PSAT testing list, <u>a fee of \$19.00</u> will appear in Infinite Campus (please allow three business days for the fee to appear). Additional testing information will be shared once a final list of students who will be testing.

Hope Squad

Hope Squad is a school-based peer support team, made up of students who are nominated by their peers, that partners with local mental health agencies. Research shows that children and young adults who are contemplating suicide are more likely to reach out to their peers than the adults in their lives. In this way, Hope Squad members are the "eyes and ears" of the school building – monitoring for warning signs of suicide and helping to connect their peers with staff members who can offer the appropriate resources in times of need. The Unified School District of De Pere has Hope Squad teams at Foxview, DPMS, and DPHS.

Teens can obtain a permit in WI at age 15.

- Teens will not be allowed to apply for their probationary license until they are at **least 16 years old**, **hold** their permit for at least 6 months ticket free, practice hours of at least 50 hours and 10 of those at night, and have completed all of driver education (classroom and BTW lessons).
- Another change is that the **permit will be good for 18 months** instead of 12 months. All 16-17 year olds **will have to take the road test.**
- The new law changes the number of practice hours required during the permit phase, it changed from **30** hours to **50** hours. The DMV does not collect the practice driving record when teens go for their road test however they may ask to see it or the **Road Ready app** which also tracks practice time.
- Your teen should work toward at least 100 hours of practice with 30 of those at night based on national
 recommendations put forth by AAA Foundation research in order to give novice drivers more experience
 before licensing (shows it reduces crashes after licensing). Our common goal for everyone is to have
 fewer crashes, injuries, and fatalities involving teens and all other drivers. Use of the Road Ready app is
 a great tool for them to track their progress of practice hours.

Who is eligible to enroll? Any student who is 14 years/10 months to 18 years old. Sign up information is located on the De Pere High School webpage under the "Students" tab under the Driver's Education link. You could also go to http://cesa2.com to access information regarding Driver's Education at De Pere High School.
