CCPS Pivots to Virtual Learning/Work Day on September 26 & District Closure on September 27 Due to Inclement Weather

JONESBORO - The leadership of Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS), based on updated information from the National Weather Service and in conjunction with neighboring school districts, has announced that Thursday, September 26, will be a virtual learning day.

All students in grades PreK-12 will **remain home** for asynchronous (independent) learning. All district staff will **remain home** and **work virtually**. The only exceptions will be essential CCPS personnel such as members of our law enforcement and facilities maintenance.
