
KINDERGARTEN

Kindergarten worked on
Mosaic name art. Since the
students are working hard on

students talked about

form of art in which surfaces
are covered by small pieces
like stone or tile.



SECOND GRADE CHAL; LENGE

Students learned about the artist Etel Adnan. They created simple landscapes using three lines. These lines represent their different characteristics. They used art terms such as line, tint, shade, and landscape when creating these art pieces.

FIRST GRADE

First Grade students studied the artist Wassily Kandinsky. They made a model of his concentric circles. They discussed shapes and lines as well as different colors during this project. This study was included in their discussion of how to build a classroom community through their reading of the book Our Class is a Family. They also made self portraits as a way to celebrate their different contributions to their classroom community.



SECOND GRADE

Students are learning about one another and learning to describe themselves using appropriate adjectives. They created symmetrical self portraits by creating the second half of their face to match half of a photograph. They learned what symmetry is and how to find a line of symmetry. They also practiced their writing skills as they wrote about their interests. The students got to use a variety of art materials for this project.
