Community

Seneca Falls is the largest town in Seneca County and is located within the Finger Lakes Region. Seneca Falls is the center of a large agricultural area, the location of the Northeast College of Life Sciences (formerly New York Chiropractic College), and home to industries producing a variety of products. Tourists are attracted to the area by the Women's Rights National Historical Park, the privately-supported National Women's Hall of Fame, plus recreational opportunities at area State parks.

School System

The Seneca Falls Central School District covers the townships of Seneca Falls, Fayette, and Tyre. There are two elementary schools (grades UPK-2 and 3-5), the Seneca Falls Middle School (grades 6-8), and Mynderse Academy High School (grades 9-12). The total public school population for 2024-2025 is approximately 1,158 students, with 355 students in grades 9-12. There are 91 students in the Class of 2025.

Grading System

- Mynderse Academy utilizes a 100 point grading system
- Passing grades are 65-100
- Grades of 64 and below are failing

Class Ranking System

- Class rank is based on the cumulative weighted grade point average
- Jazz Band, Vocal Jazz, and Chamber Singers and those courses receiving a letter grade are not included in calculation of cumulative GPA.

Course Weighting Policy

- Honors (H) courses and any collegiate level/dual enrollment courses are weighted an additional 5% in the cumulative GPA.
- Advanced Placement (AP) courses are weighted an additional 10% in the cumulative GPA.
