You may have already received your child's state testing results, which were mailed out recently. - AK Star Assessments provide a baseline to evaluate student performance and growth within the State of Alaska.
- When compared to national assessments, Alaska has set a high standard for achievement with AK Star Assessments. Educators at CCSD as well as across the state are striving to meet those standards.
- Approaching proficient doesn't mean students are failing, rather it means students are making progress towards the high standards set by the State of Alaska.
- NWEA Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) and M-Class Testing are administered throughout the school year. These assessments help keep staff and parents/guardians regularly informed on student performance and growth. All these assessments as well as the informal and formal assessments provided by your child's teacher help provide the full story of your child's progress and achievement.

If you happen to have any questions regarding your child's testing results, please don't hesitate to reach out to your child's teacher, your child's school principal, CCSD's testing coordinator, and/or myself directly. We are all here to support your child's learning journey.
