SCHOOLMESSENGER®

As you know, we are in the middle of transferring our school messaging system from SwiftK12 (currently using but going away) to School Messenger. This has been quite the process and we will be testing the new system today. Please expect to get this newsletter TWICE. We will use the next few weeks where we you will get newsletters from BOTH systems to make sure that everything is going through. If something seems off, please reach out to the front desk. One change will be that you need to Opt-In to Receive Text Messages.

Text "Y" to 67587 from each wireless device you wish to receive texts on. The wireless number must be listed in PowerSchool for that student to receive messages.

If you receive a text message that says it is from SchoolMessenger (67587), it will most likely be the Opt-In message so don't ignore!



Go Guardian Parent Access:

Subject line: Welcome to GoGuardian Parent!

Welcome! Our school will be granting you access to GoGuardian, a mobile app designed to provide parents/guardians insight and control over their student's online activity when on schoolmanaged devices and accounts. First, the GoGuardian Parent app provides an overview of your children's online activity on schoolmanaged devices and accounts - this overview includes the apps, extensions, documents, and websites your student visited. Second, GoGuardian Parent provides you with an additional set of internet controls that you can set for out-of-school hours. GoGuardian Parent was created to help provide students additional educational support and is a companion to the classroom engagement and internet filtering tools that our school uses.

What is included in this app:

- Top 5 overview of your student's online activity
- Any teacher interventions related to your student's online activity
- 30-day overview of your student's online activity
- Ability to block websites on school-issued devices during outof-school hours
- Ability to pause internet access on school-issued devices during out-of-school hours, either on-demand or at a scheduled time

To access the app, please follow the below instructions:

- 1. Download the app via Apple Store or Google Play Store
- After the app is successfully downloaded and installed, open it up and enter the email address registered with the school.
 Note: If you forgot your registered email address, please reach out to front desk.
- 3. Login/Check Email: Check your email on your phone for a link to log in to the app. Tap the "Verify your email", and it will take you straight to the app. Note: If you don't have access to your email through the device you used to log in, tap on "Login with verification code", and copy and paste the verification code from the email into the app.

Unfortunately, Albuquerque Aviation Academy is not immune to these statistics. Here is what cheating can look like...






Having someone else do your work



Using Google or anther online platform to get the answer, especially during a quiz or test





Using a script bot or similar Al to complete your work

Use the STOPit mobile app to anonymously report incidents to your school. Reporting is completely anonymous. You can include text, images or video. It only takes a few minutes

What can you report?

- Bullying
- Cyberbullying
- Harassment
- Violence, threats, or weapons possession
- Alcohol or drug related issues
- Discrimination

How STOPit Works?

- 1 Submit a tip via mobile app, website or 24/7 phone hotline
- Incident Response Center monitors and reviews your submission
- 3 School Administrators receive and act on tip submission


