



Hello! My name is Nathalie Flores, and I am the Trip Reduction Program (TRP) Coordinator for the Kyrene School District. All organizations with 50 or more employees must participate in Maricopa County's TRP, the goal of which is to reduce drive-alone commute traffic. As part of the community, the Kyrene School District supports the efforts of the Trip Reduction Program to reduce air pollution and improve our quality of life. Become an Alternative Mode User (AMU) to gain benefits not offered to coworkers who commute by driving alone. AMUs carpool or vanpool, take the bus or light rail, ride their bikes, or walk during the commute.

As an incentive for this program, Kyrene offers:

- We provide preferential parking for carpoolers. Two spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis. You must be a registered AMU and have a carpool dash tag to use them.
- The Guaranteed Ride Home program in case of emergencies such as: illness, family emergencies, or other unforeseen problems. AMUs will be provided - and limited to one (1) emergency ride in each 6-month period beginning with their registration in the program. Emergency rides may not be accumulated or carried over.
- Bicycle Parking
- An information center with bus, carpooling, zip code matching, high pollution advisories and more.
- Monthly prize drawings valued from \$25-\$50 for new and continuing alternative mode users (AMU), Best AMU, and moving closer to your work site.
- Survey Incentive Drawings

If you are interested in carpooling, walking, bicycling, riding the public transportation system, head to the ShareTheRide portal. Click on "register" to begin the process. Once logged in, you can find other carpool participants, create planned commutes, and log your trips. Important: Without activating your calendar, and logging your commutes, you will not be entered into the drawings. Employees may also contact Valley Metro Rideshare at 602-262-7433 for more information.

After you find someone to ride share with, please come to the Transportation office, or reach out to the site TC to sign up and get your carpool tag!
