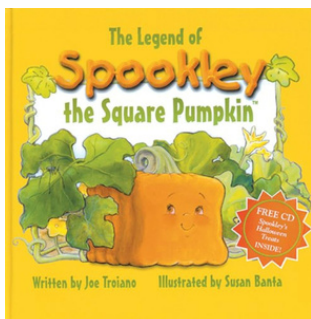

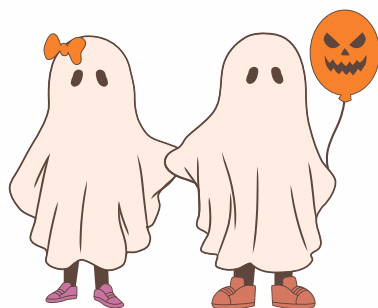
BE INCLUSIVE
