BLMS TERMINOLOGY

TEAM

All grades will be placed on a team. Students on the same team will have the same core teachers throughout the day.

CORE CLASSES

6 & 7th grades have 4 core classes (Integrated English, Science, Social Studies, and Math)

8th Grade has 5 core classes (American History, Integrated English, Social Studies and Math.

UNIFIED ARTS

Unified Arts Classes are electives that the students must choose. Options include

6th grade – Performing Arts (Band, Choir or Strings)

7th grade- Performing Arts, Health/PE, and Visual Arts courses.

8th grade – Performing Arts, World Language courses, Computer Technology courses, and Family Consumer Science courses.

UNIFIED ARTS 6 WEEK ROTATION

There are 36 weeks of Unified Arts courses throughout the school year. Each 6 weeks, students will change to a different Unified Arts Class.

Q & A

Q: How do I access my student's grades online?

A: PowerSchool is where you can check your student's grades in all classes. Log-In information for this program can be obtained by contacting the BLMS main office.

Q: Who is my student's school counselor? How do I get in touch with them?

A: We have 2 counselors at BLMS. Jayme Davis works with students whose last names begin with the letters A-K. Jenna Purlee works with students whose last names begin with the letters L-Z. To get in touch with your student's counselor, you may email or call.

Q: What is the Bruin Bulletin?

A: The Bruin Bulletin is a weekly newsletter which is emailed out to parents every Friday. The newsletter contains important dates and information for parents about upcoming school events and activities.

Q: How does my student sign up for Sports?

A: Watch for information to come home in the Bruin Bulletin, School Announcements or on our BLMS Athletic Website for upcoming meetings or try-outs. School sponsored sports are only for current 7th & 8th graders.

Q: How do I notify the school if my child will be absent from school?

A: Call the Attendance line as soon as you know your student will be absent from school. If it is a planned absence, have your student bring a note from the parent/guardian to the attendance office explaining the date, time, and reason for the absence.

Q & A CONTINUED

Q: Do I need to provide a Dr. Note if my student is absent due to an appointment?

A: Yes! You will need to provide a note from your doctor, dentist, or orthodontist if your student misses school due to an appointment. If we do not receive a note from the doctor the absence will be considered "unexcused".

Q: Is my student allowed to ride the bus home with a friend after school?

A: No. Students may not ride busses that they are not assigned to.

Q: What is PowerSchool and Schoology?

A: These are both online tools used by OLSLD for parents and students to access student information. To access each of the tools, visit the district website at Olentangy.k12.oh.us and then select **Parent Resources**. You will need a school assigned Access ID and Password to link multiple students to your accounts. Please contact the main office to receive your Access Information.

Q: How do I pay school fees or Pay to Play fees?

A: All fees are paid online through your parent PowerSchool acct.

Q: How do I add money on my student's lunch account?

A: You will use your parent PowerSchool account to add money or pay outstanding balances to a student's lunch account
