# Signs of Suicide (SOS) Program

Ohio House Bill 123, also known as the <u>SAVE Students Act</u>, requires schools to provide annual instruction in suicide awareness and prevention education for students in grades 6 through 12. On October 9 and 10, students in grade 9 will receive education using the state-approved, evidence-based Signs of Suicide (SOS) program. Parents of ninth grade students can elect to have their child screened for depression <u>by completing the consent form linked here</u>. Students in grades 10, 11, and 12 will receive SOS prevention programming later in the month. The goal of the program is to help students recognize the signs of depression and to impress upon students that they can help themselves or a friend by taking the simple step of talking to a responsible adult about their concerns.
