



BOBBY DUKE MIDDLE SCHOOL DRESS CODE 2024-2025

1. Shoes must be worn at all times. Sandals must be closed-toe and must have a heel strap (i.e. Crocs in sports-mode). “Slip-On” sports sandals, flip-flops, shoes with spikes or other sharp objects/materials and slippers of any type are NOT allowed. Heels above 2” may not be worn.
2. Clothing that causes any major school or classroom destruction is prohibited.
3. Clothing, headwear, backpacks, and jewelry shall be free from tagging, pictures, or any other insignias, symbols, or emblems which are crude, vulgar, and profane or suggest any act which is immoral, illegal, or hazardous to one’s health
4. Articles of clothing, must not include the following
 - Logos/symbols and colors may be excluded based on problems created by them on or off campus during the school year.
 - Items that advocate racial, ethnic, or religious prejudice or the use of drugs, tobacco or alcohol.
 - Bandanas (use of headbands, wristbands or ankle bands), hairnets, or nylon stockings.
 - Any garments, hats, or accessories displaying emblems of outside clubs or gang affiliations.
5. Any article of clothing, headwear, or jewelry that can be construed to have a “double meaning”.
6. Clothing must cover all undergarments, on both males (muscle shirts, underwear) and females (bra, underwear).
7. No undershirts, spaghetti strap tops, backless blouses, halter/tube tops, and sport bras. Exercise tops are allowed on campus.
8. T-shirts, blouses, and all tops must not expose any amount of cleavage or stomach.
9. See-through, or fishnet fabrics must have a garment other than underclothing underneath.
10. Excessively revealing clothes are not allowed (cutouts, low cut tops, bodysuits).
11. Short dresses, and skirts must be of sufficient length to reach mid-thigh.
12. Excessively baggy pants are not acceptable. Pants must be worn over the hips for both males and females.
13. Students are not allowed to wear sunglasses in the classroom.

In case of questionable dress not covered in the expectations above, a site administrator will make a final decision. Except in the case of shoes, students found to be in violation of the dress code will be allowed to call home for a change of clothes. In order to minimize the amount of instructional time lost, students will be offered clean loaner clothing to change into. Students will be expected to return loaners the next day.
