

#### Junior Check Ins with Academic Counselors

In line with Ann Sobrato's guiding principle Life Long Learning, we believe that students must develop the skills, knowledge and enthusiasm to expand their post-secondary, career and educational opportunities to be lifelong learners.

During the week of Oct 7th-11th, Academic Counselors will be scheduling individual appointments with Junior students to discuss graduation status and post secondary plans. Students will be assigned a Minga pass and should check in with their teacher prior to leaving for their appointment.

#### Get PSAT/NMSQT Ready!

- On Wednesday, October 23, 2024 Sobrato High School students will be taking the PSAT/NMSQT test on site at Sobrato High School during the regular school day. To be eligible to become a National Merit Scholar and/or recognized by College Board recognition programs, 11th graders must take the PSAT during their Junior Year.
- <u>10th and 11th graders</u>: Sobrato High School students in the 10th Grade and 11th grades will have the option to take the exam free of charge. If 10th and 11th grade students do not register using <u>this link</u> by October 16th, 2024, there will not be a test ordered for them. Students will need to register using their MHUSD student account.
- <u>9th graders</u>: **9th grade students can reserve a seat for the PSAT/NMSQT exam for a nominal fee of \$27 by clicking on the** <u>link</u> **and purchasing a seat at the ASB store.** For **10th and 11th graders, tests do not need to be purchased on the ASB website**, in order to reserve your space. 10th and 11th grade students who choose to take the exam, will complete an interest form and will be registered by administration.
- In order to take the exam, you also must create your free <u>College Board account</u>. If you are creating a new account, it is better to use an email that is NOT your student email so you can access your scores even after you graduate. If you already have an account using your student email, please log-on using your

student email, but try to change this email in the future. When you create your account, please store your password in a safe place! We cannot help you recover your password. If you lose it, you will have to call College Board directly to reset your password.

- Check out the <u>College Board</u> website for FREE test prep resources.
- Calculators will be provided in the digital test, but if you want to bring your own calculator then click the <u>link</u> to review approved calculators by CollegeBoard. If you have a calculator, please bring an approved calculator on the day of the exam.

#### Why Take the PSAT?

The Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT/NMSQT) helps students prepare for the SAT and is used to qualify students for merit-based scholarships and advanced learning opportunities.

- Could help students qualify for scholarships. The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) for students is a program co-sponsored by the College Board and National Merit Scholarship Corp. (NMSC). 11th Grade students must take this exam to be eligible for National-Merit based Scholarships.
- Provides valuable feedback on strengths and the skills necessary for college study. Students can then focus their preparation on areas that could most benefit from additional study or practice. The PSAT measures critical reading skills, math problem-solving skills and writing skills.
- Gives insight on how a performance on an admissions test compares to others applying to college. Helps students prepare for the SAT. Students will become familiar with the kinds of questions and the exact directions they will see on the SAT.

#### On-Campus SAT, October 22nd

The SAT will be offered on campus to Sobrato students on October 22nd during the school day. Please keep in mind that private schools or out of state schools might require the SAT, but CSU, UCs, community colleges, and trade schools do not require it. The test will be \$60 and is digital. Students must bring their fully charged chromebooks. Space is limited to 100 students and Seniors will have priority through September 30th. Beginning October 1st, it will be first come, first serve to other grade levels.

To sign up for the October 22 SAT exam, students must fill out <u>this Google form</u> using their MHUSD student email account. Once students are approved for the test, they will receive more details on how to pay for the exam. If students need financial assistance, please complete the <u>District Benefit Program form</u> by September 30th and indicate in the Google form that financial assistance is being requested.

For the March 11, 2025 SAT exam, juniors will have priority registration. More details will be shared in February 2025.
