Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up...

Thank you for your patience during these first weeks of school- there can be delays the first week as bus routes and processes continue to be adjusted. We would kindly request the following of our parents:

- Exiting our lot is a **Right Turn Only** for parent traffic- thank you.
- Please do not use the bus parking lot area- that lot is reserved for school bus access and has student foot traffic.
- Please do not pick up or drop off students in our lower lot behind the school.
- Please do not park on Bauer Road or the adjacent subdivision.
- Please remember our "7 Second" drop off target time if you are dropping your student off at Maltby in the morning. Having the kids ready to go and out of the car quickly helps the line move efficiently.
- Students are **not** permitted to walk to our sidewalks from the interior parking spaces- please make sure you escort your student to and from the sidewalks if they cannot get out directly onto a sidewalk.
- We have noticed there are times in the morning and afternoon when parents are waiting in a very long drop off line but there are spots open in the main lot- if you wind up in the unfortunate circumstance that you are blocking traffic while waiting for the drop off line to move...please consider pulling into the main lot and parking and walking your student to the sidewalk or picking them up from the main lot. Thank you for your cooperation and patience in the morning and afternoon. We realize how busy we all are but we must all take the time to ensure our children are safe in the parking lot by following the guidelines.

Thank you again for your consideration. Mr. Aten, Officer Mitchell, and I appreciate the waves and smiles each morning. We anticipate our traffic flow times will improve slightly as everyone gets used to the patterns.

If your student is going to be absent from school, please use our convenient twenty-four-hour absence call-in line (810) 299-3688.

- Please obtain a doctor's note to receive a medically excused absence.
- Please call when your student will be coming in late.
- You must call in each day that your child is absent.
- Please call no later than 9:00 a.m. on the day of the absence.
- Students arriving late to school should be dropped off at the flag pole door (Door # 1).
- Do not drive off until your student has rang the doorbell and is inside the building.
- Students arriving late to school must report to the office to sign in. Parents do not need to come inside.

EARLY DISMISSALS:

- Please send in a note for the **office**, if possible, or call ahead for early dismissals by 3:05pm.
- Please call when you arrive and we will send your student out. You do not need to come in.
- We will only allow students to be signed out by people who are listed on the emergency card unless other arrangements have been made with the office.

We use Little Caesars Pizza Kit Fundraiser to help with the cost of our 5th Grade Camp!



Michigan School Meals 2024-25

Brighton Area Schools will participate in the **Michigan School Meals Program** for the 2024-25 school year. **Michigan School Meals** is a state-funded program that provides reimbursement for meals, so all students receive the meals at no cost.

To participate, students just need to show up and take a qualified meal. A school lunch consists of five components: protein, grain, fruit, vegetable and fluid milk. For a lunch to qualify *it must consist of a minimum of three of the five components and one of those must be a fruit or vegetable.* Incomplete meals and individual meal components will be charged at a la carte pricing.

Families are strongly encouraged to complete the **EDUCATION BENEFITS APPLICATION**. Students and families may qualify for other District program fee reductions based on their eligibility. This includes SAT testing, Pay-to-Participate and more.


The number of eligible students helps secure additional funding for the District including Title I funding.




