

## Michigan School Meals 2024-25

Brighton Area Schools will participate in the **Michigan School Meals Program** for the 2024-25 school year. **Michigan School Meals** is a state-funded program that provides reimbursement for meals, so all students receive the meals at no cost.

To participate, students just need to show up and take a qualified meal. A school lunch consists of five components: protein, grain, fruit, vegetable and fluid milk. For a lunch to qualify *it must consist of a minimum of three of the five components* and one of those must be a fruit or vegetable. Incomplete meals and individual meal components will be charged at a la carte pricing.

Families are strongly encouraged to complete the **EDUCATION BENEFITS APPLICATION**. Students and families may qualify for other District program fee reductions based on their eligibility. This includes SAT testing, Pay-to-Participate and more.

The number of eligible students helps secure additional funding for the District including Title I funding.
