The following groups are avaliable to students during lunch throughout the school week. Please see next page for more information.





How is Beginning Band & Orchestra offered?

- Classes: Students meet daily for one class period for the entire year. 6th Grade Beginning Band and Orchestra classes are elective (exploratory) classes.
- Beginning Band: Students begin instruction on flute, clarinet, alto saxophone, french horn, trumpet, trombone, baritone, tuba, or percussion (includes both snare drum and bells).
