STEM Education

STEM Education is an interdisciplinary approach to teaching which focuses on one or more of the four disciplines of science, technology, engineering, and math. Exposing children to STEM learning in the early years is key. It boosts curiosity, making the learning process fun, relevant everlasting and thus develops a generation of future innovators. KG students are introduced to many STEM activities throughout the school year and take part in a full STEM week which includes dress-up days, theme-based assemblies, stories, songs, crafts and STEM lessons in the classroom.

Aftercare Program

This program is offered to Pre-K and KG students whose parents cannot pick them up at dismissal time and registration is on a space-available basis. Aftercare has daily activities that include Library, Computer Lab, Science, Math, Arts & Crafts, Playground, P.E. and weekly movies. At the end of each quarter our Aftercare students get a special party!

Library & Reading Program

The KG Department has its very own library with a comprehensive selection of age-appropriate books, storytelling kits, felt board sets and puppets. KG classes have a special visit to the library built into their weekly schedule. To further encourage reading at home, Super Reader certificates are awarded to KG2 students who complete their home reading logs each semester.

Character Education

The Character Education Program is designed to offer instruction to KG2 students to help them develop their awareness of others and their interactions within their school community and beyond. This program focuses on one pre-selected "pillar" per month which promotes core ethical values. A special assembly is held that includes skits, songs and discussion to introduce and teach the ideas behind each selected value and a certificate is awarded to one student per class who exemplifies the character pillar of the month.

Weekly Superstars

Every Thursday, the KG Department has a Superstar Assembly. One special student is chosen from each class for excellence in academics, behavior, or citizenship. The students wear a regal cape and crown and are honored with a certificate, story and special surprise!

Spring Concert Student Performances (PK-KGI)

The annual KG Spring Concert is held each year for our PreK and KG1 students prior to the Spring Break holiday in March or April. Our students are the stars of the show dressed up in costumes to match the theme. Past themes have included Space, Oceans of Fun, Eric Carle and Dr. Seuss!

Graduation Ceremonies (KG2)

KG2 Graduation ceremonies take place at the end of each school year. It is a pleasure to see all of the KG2 graduates celebrate together with their parents and teachers.
