FILLING SCHOOL BOARD VACANCIES

In the event a vacancy occurs on the Board of Education, the vacancy shall be filled by appointment of the remaining members of the Board in accordance with established procedures.

Any qualified elector of the District may apply to fill the vacancy.

Candidates for a vacancy on the Board shall be considered at a properly noticed open Board meeting. Boards may interview candidates in a closed session only if the discussion involves financial, medical, social or personal histories or disciplinary data that, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of the person. A majority vote of the remaining members of the Board shall be required for all appointments to fill a Board vacancy. Boards may take a roll call; voice vote or vote using signed written ballots.

The candidate appointed to the vacancy shall, pending acceptance and filing the oath of office, be seated on the Board. New Board members shall be given orientation to the duties and responsibilities of a school board member.
